

What is KI-HIPP?

The Kentucky Integrated Health Insurance Premium Payment program (KI-HIPP) helps eligible Medicaid members pay the cost of a Group Health Insurance plan.

Benefits of the program include:

- May make family coverage more affordable by covering premium costs
- May widen healthcare networks by providing access to additional services via KI-HIPP providers
- Increases participation in the commercial health insurance market, saving taxpayer dollars
- Helps families have more extensive coverage at a lower cost

Who is eligible for KI-HIPP?

Individuals or families may be eligible for KI-HIPP if they are:



Medicaid eligible or in a Medicaid member household

Enrolled in or have access to insurance through current or past employment

How does someone enroll?

In order to qualify for KI-HIPP, an individual must be a Medicaid member and have access to a group medical insurance plan. To enroll, follow this process:
