The Department for Medicaid Services is making changes to the Kentucky Medicaid Preferred Drug List (PDL) based on recommendations from the Kentucky Medicaid Pharmacy & Therapeutics Advisory Committee at its November 18, 2010 meeting and as adopted by the Cabinet for Health and Family Services' Secretary by order dated December 22, 2010.

On April 13, 2011, the following changes will be effective:

- ***Drug Class Changes***
 - ***Atypical Antipsychotics***
 - ***Abilify^{® QL}, clozapine^{QL}, Fanapt^{™ QL}, Fazaclo^{® QL}, Geodon^{® QL}, risperidone^{QL}, Saphris^{® QL}, Seroquel^{® QL}, Seroquel^{® XR QL} and Zyprexa^{® QL} will remain **preferred** and require PA.***
 - ***Clozaril^{® QL} and Invega^{® QL} will become **non-preferred** and require PA. Patients currently stable on Invega[®] will be allowed to continue therapy.***
 - ***Risperdal^{® QL} will remain **non-preferred** and require PA.***
 - ***Atypical Antipsychotics PA criteria.***
 - ***Preferred Atypical Antipsychotics will be allowed for approvable diagnoses only. A full listing of approvable diagnoses is attached to this notice.***

- *Non-preferred Atypical Antipsychotics will be approved after a 2-week trial of ONE preferred Atypical Antipsychotic at an appropriate dose. However, patients currently stable and compliant on a non preferred product will be allowed to continue therapy.*
- *Invega® will be approved if one of the following is true:*
 - *Trial and failure of risperidone ; OR*
 - *Patient has hepatic impairment evident by elevated liver enzymes or a diagnosis suggestive of hepatic impairment*
- *For a diagnosis not specifically mentioned above, an atypical may be approved if the prescriber can provide documented clinical evidence (peer reviewed literature or multiple case studies) supporting the use of the requested medication for the requested indication.*
- *Major Depressive Disorder (MDD) Criteria:*
 - *Atypical Antipsychotics will be approved for MDD as adjunct therapy ONLY. Atypicals will be approved if any ONE of the following is true:*
 - *An adequate trial (4 weeks) of at least one agent in two of the following classes of antidepressants (unless contraindicated or intolerant to):*
 - *Selective Serotonins Reuptake Inhibitor (SSRIs)*
 - *Serotonin-Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitor (SNRIs)*
 - *New Generation Antidepressants*
 - *Tricyclic antidepressants (TCAs); OR*
 - *A diagnosis of Major Depressive Disorder (MDD) with psychotic features.*
- *Multiple Agents Criteria:*
 - *Patients who are on more than 2 Atypical Antipsychotic agents will require PA. Approval will be granted for the following reasons:*
 - *A maximum of 2 months to allow patients to taper to dual therapy.*
 - *Additional agents may be added to existing dual therapy after a 2-week trial at the maximum tolerated dose of each agent.*
 - *Of note: Patients currently stable on more than 2 Atypical Antipsychotic agents will require pro-active prior authorization so that current therapy will not be interrupted.*

- Non-preferred Injectable Antipsychotics will be approved after a 2-week trial of ONE preferred Antipsychotic (oral or parenteral) at an appropriate dose.
- For a diagnosis not specifically mentioned above, an injectable antipsychotic may be approved if the prescriber can provide documented clinical evidence (peer reviewed literature or multiple case studies) supporting the use of the requested medication for the requested indication.
- Multiple Therapy Criteria:
 - Patients who are on more than two Atypical Antipsychotic agents will require PA. Approval will be granted for the following reasons:
 - A maximum of 2 months to allow patients to taper to dual therapy.
 - Additional agents may be added to existing dual therapy after a 2-week trial at the maximum tolerated dose if each agent.

- Of note: Patients currently stable on more than 2 Atypical Antipsychotic agents will require pro-active prior authorization so that current therapy will not be interrupted.
