Only patients who are unable to swallow or tolerate oral medications should be approved for non-oral formulations of agents in this class. Continue current quantity limits on all agents in this class. Agents not selected as preferred will be considered non preferred and require PA. For any new chemical entity in the Urinary Tract Antispasmodic Class, require a PA until reviewed by the P&T Advisory Committee.

Agents not selected as preferred will be considered non preferred and require prior authorization Allow continuation of therapy for non preferred single source branded products via a 90 day look back. For any new chemical entity in the Antipsychotics: Typical class, require a PA until reviewed by the P&T Advisory Committee. 		
Atypical Antipsychotics	 DMS to select preferred agent(s) based on economic evaluation; however, at least five unique chemical entities should be preferred. Require appropriate ICD-9 on all prescriptions for agents within this class. Place quantity limits on all agents in the class. Allow only two agents at a time unless switching agents due to therapeutic failure or the patient is refractory to dual therapy. Allow continuation of therapy for non preferred single source branded products via a 90 day look back. All products in the category should have a tier 1 copay regardless of preferred or non preferred status. For any new chemical entity in the Antipsychotics: Atypical class, require a PA until reviewed by the P&T Advisory Committee.

 - New Generation Antidepressants
 - Tricyclic antidepressants (TCAs); OR
- A diagnosis of Major Depressive Disorder (MDD) with psychotic features.

^{**}For a diagnosis not specifically mentioned above, an atypical may be approved if the prescriber can provide documented clinical evidence (peer reviewed literature or multiple case studies) supporting the use of the requested medication for the requested indication.

Multiple Agents Criteria:

Patients who are on more than 2 Atypical Antipsychotic agents will require PA. Approval will be granted for the following reasons:

- A maximum of 2 months to allow patients to taper to dual therapy.
- Additional agents may be added to existing dual therapy after a 2-week trial at the maximum tolerated dose of each agent.
